AN ENTREPRENEURIAL HERITAGE

Heinrich Moser was born in Schaffhausen, Switzerland, in 1805. Born into a family of watchmakers, he quickly developed his expertise and gained international renown. In 1828, he founded H. Moser & Cie. in St. Petersburg, which rapidly became a great success. In 1829, he built a factory in Le Locle (Switzerland), importing and distributing his creations through his own boutiques in Russia, as well as in Central Asia, Persia, and China, thanks to a network of distributors. At the age of 43 years, this prosperous and visionary entrepreneur returned to Schaffhausen and contributed

to industrial expansion within the region. After the death of Heinrich Moser, H. Moser & Cie. was passed between different entrepreneurs before disappearing at the end of the 1970s. In 2005, Roger Nicholas Balsiger, great grandson of Heinrich Moser, was the driving force behind the relaunch of H. Moser & Cie. and their new Manufacture. In 2012, control of the company passed to the Meylan family in order to create an independent watchmaking group that could benefit not just its members but generations to come.



THE BRAND

Already known for its firm stance and plain speaking, H. Moser & Cie. is the defender of traditional Swiss mechanical watchmaking. Defying received standards, and continually challenging itself to ensure it moves forward, H. Moser & Cie. occupies a distinct position on the market. As an independent brand, owned by a Swiss family, it enjoys a significant degree of freedom and autonomy. Extremely responsive, H. Moser & Cie. fosters a quirky approach to communication that breaks with convention, and designs products which are classic yet firmly in the spirit of the times, utterly contemporary and resolutely timeless. Notable amongst these is the first 100% Swiss watch, the Swiss Mad Watch with a case made out of cheese. H. Moser & Cie. used this symbol to reignite the debate around the Swiss Made label, which it deems too lenient and unconvincing. It was behind the #makeswissmadegreatagain campaign.

AN INTEGRATED MANUFACTURE

Irreverent Haute Horlogerie for those in the know.

Our passion for innovation and our entrepreneurial heritage are our driving forces. To date, we have developed more than 12 calibres, all designed and produced entirely in-house over the last decade. We manufacture the majority of the components in our movements, including the hairsprings and regulating organs. This gives us total control over quality, which is very rare in watch manufacturing today.

Complexity made simple.

Elegance and understatement have become our signature style. Our movements also comply with these same requirements. They are reliable and include various functions designed to make our clients' lives easier – the Straumann® double hairspring improves isochronism and timekeeping, a minimum power reserve of

3-7 days, the Double Pull Crown system can adjust other functions without affecting the time display, the interchangeable escapement module simplifies adjustment, cleaning and servicing of the watch, and there is even the hacking seconds function that allows the watch to be set precisely to the second.

To innovate, you have to challenge yourself. For the first time in its history, H. Moser & Cie has revisited its time display methods to create a new, disc-based system. The mechanism is inspired by the planetary systems that led to the birth of modern, independent watchmaking. Adopting a technical approach that respects the elegant, understated style of H. Moser & Cie., the result is an exceptionally refined time measuring instrument. The Endeavour Flying Hours represents a major step for H. Moser & Cie. This remarkable modular development is based on its automatic HMC 200 calibre, which has been modified to create the HMC 806 movement.

ENDEAVOUR PERPETUAL CALENDAR

Our perpetual calendar is the ultimate in terms of simplicity and ingenuity. A short arrow-shaped hand uses the hour indices to indicate the month. Thanks to the Flash Calendar system, the date change happens instantaneously at midnight. The time can be adjusted forwards or backwards at any moment without any risk to the movement.

This combination of exceptional solutions led the Endeavour Perpetual Calendar to be recognised at the Geneva Watchmaking Grand Prix in 2006, in the complicated watches category.

Flash Calendar

Unlike most other calendars which change gradually, an H. Moser Flash Calendar is very rare in that it changes from one date to the next in a fraction of a second. This characteristic, which can be found on both the Venturer Big Date and the Endeavour Perpetual Calendar, is particularly impressive and useful on the Perpetual Calendar, as the date instantaneously changes at midnight to the correct date, even on short months such as February.

In our automatic movements, we use an ingenious pawl winding system to transfer the energy derived from the solid gold rotor to the barrel. This system enables the rotor to wind the watch when turning in either direction, reducing the time to fully wind the watch.

The escapement module

The interchangeable H. Moser & Cie. escapement module is one of our cleverest features; developed to simplify the adjustment, cleaning and servicing of the watch. It enables the watchmaker to remove the existing escapement module, clean and oil the rest of the movement before installing a new pre-adjusted module. Most watches have only a single hairspring, but H. Moser & Cie. has developed this module with a Straumann® Double Hair-spring which is available on a select few timepieces in our collection.

The regulating organs

Thanks to its sister company, Precision Engineering AG, H. Moser & Cie. possesses the expertise needed to develop and manufacture the constituent parts of the regulating organs. Balance-springs, balances, pallet forks and escapement wheels: Precision Engineering AG produces these components for H. Moser & Cie. but also for external customers. Manufacturing large runs and individual parts, Precision Engineering AG is the custom-made regulating organ specialist, and is part of the highly select group of manufactures able to produce paramagnetic escapements.






VENTURER

The Venturer collection boasts many design elements taken from the traditional pocket watch, but also a careful blend of features from the Bauhaus period of the 1920s and the convex forms typical of the 1960s. This includes a delicate bezel, with a wide opening onto the dial, and a domed sapphire crystal. The Venturer collection also includes XL models, with a 43 mm case.



VENTURER BIG DATE

The Venturer Big Date features one of the biggest date displays available. This watch boasts the H. Moser Flash Calendar system which enables instantaneous date changes. Housed in the date window, located at 3 o'clock, the big date comprises two rings lying one on top of the other; numbers 1 to 15 are found on the upper ring, and numbers 16 to 31 on the lower ring. This very rare feature means that each individual digit, regardless of size, will always appear in the centre of the date window without the need for a leading zero or blank panel.

Double Pull Crown

Thanks to the Double Pull Crown mechanism, it is easy to adjust the date both forwards and backwards, without inadvertently changing the time. This smart, simple feature allows the crown to be pulled out in two stages, the first for adjusting the date, the second for stopping the movement and setting the time. With this function, the watch continues to indicate the correct hour, minute and second without interruption when adjusting the date.

VENTURER SMALL SECONDS

The Venturer Small Seconds is infused with design elements from traditional pocket watches and clever cues from the Bauhaus era of the 1920s and convex forms of the 1960s. In particular, this includes a larger bezel opening, revealing the extremely restrained and elegant H. Moser dial.

The baton design and the swallow-shaped hands are long and slim, expressing a dynamic character. Carefully selected features are shared with other collections, such as the crown with the Moser "M" adorning its vertical flank and the curving lines of the satin-finished area embellishing the middle hoop. The resultant design engages with an arresting presence.

This is a young and funky version, a reminder that H.
